WHAT IS BLOOMSBURY OPEN COLLECTIONS?

- Bloomsbury Open Collections is a collective-action OA model – spreading the costs of publication in order to make a collection of titles to Open Access
- Each Open Collection consists of **18 titles** with a shared subject focus. Participating libraries receive **12 months' access to ~150 backlist titles** in the same subject as a benefit for their own researchers, as well as permanent access to frontlist titles in the collection in the event that we do not raise enough funds to make them open access.

WHAT SUBJECTS WILL BLOOMSBURY OPEN COLLECTIONS FOCUS ON THIS YEAR?

Following the success of previous years, we are continuing to offer **three subject collections**:

- **African Studies + International Development**
- **Environment + Climate Change**
- **Gender + Sexuality**

WHY SHOULD A LIBRARY PARTICIPATE?

- Contribute to a progressive OA funding model that aims to make 18 research titles within each collection available OA
- 12 months' access to a collection of ~150 related backlist titles as a private benefit
- Public acknowledgement on our website
- Receive permanent access to all 18 frontlist titles in your selected collection/s.

WHAT ARE BLOOMSBURY'S GOALS?

- Ensure that a more diverse range of authors benefit from OA
- Increase local access to region-specific content
- Support the commissioning of authors from low- and middle-income countries
